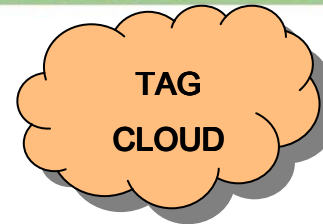

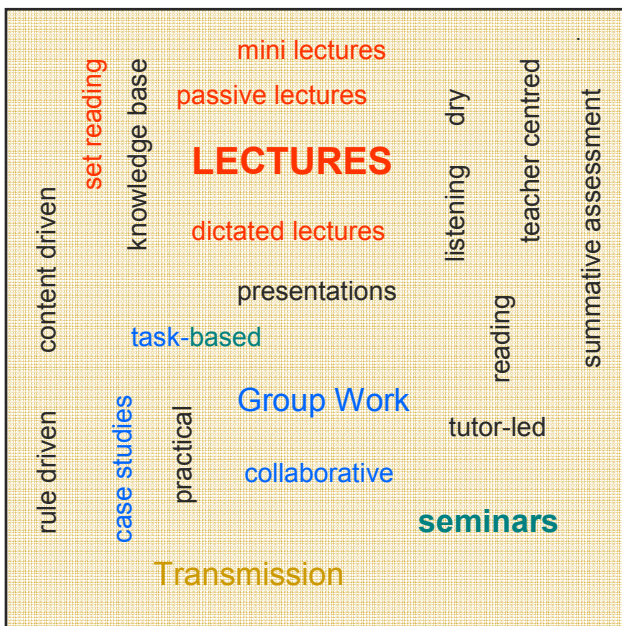


**WHAT ARE TAG CLOUDS:** A tag or word cloud is a visual depiction of analysis done on usually qualitative information. Tags are usually single words used frequently to describe a particular element of interest.

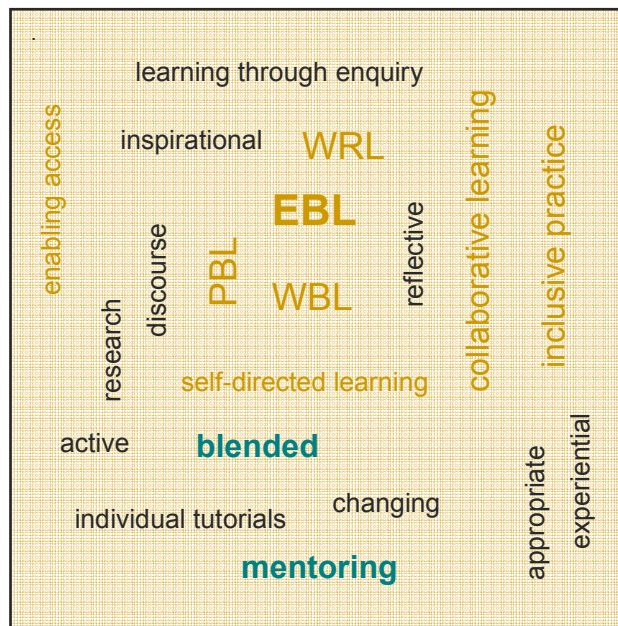


**HOW TO READ TAG CLOUDS:**  
 Words that frequently appear have a larger font and independent colour.  
 Words of similar font size have a similar frequency of occurrence.  
 Contextual or explanatory words are in a similar colour.

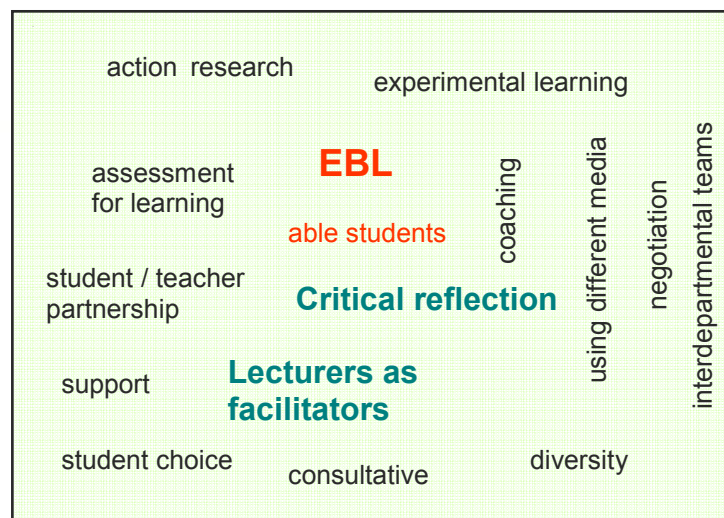
## Challenges developing autonomous learners
