Critically evaluate the value of reflective practice through the student experience.

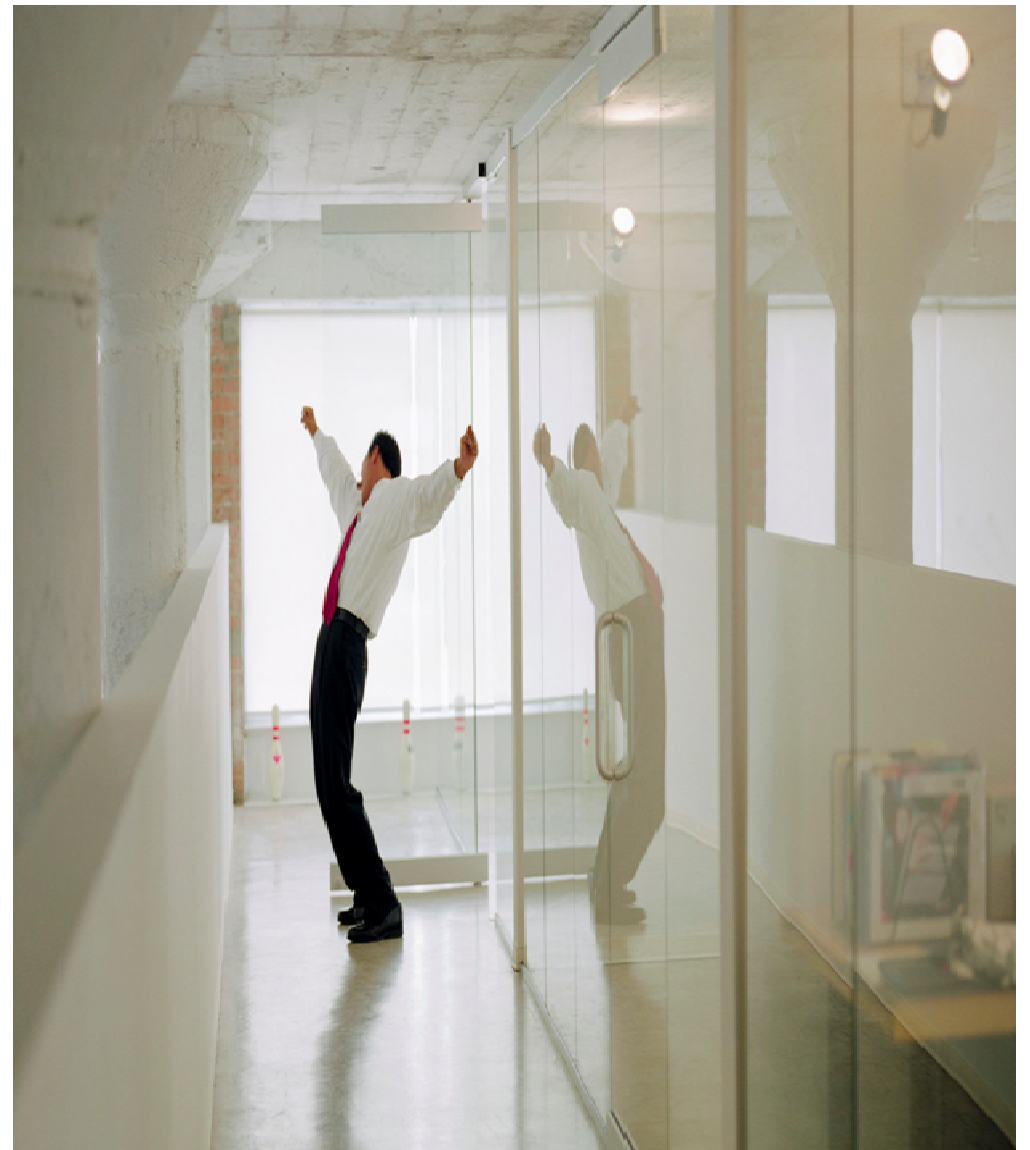
Embed the concept of Learner Autonomy through reflective practice.

Evaluate the value of action learning sets to support autonomous learning.

Disseminate across the post graduate curriculum.

**Methodology:** Focus Group research with MSc Full & Part Time student groups

Reflective practice (Schon, 1987) is a continuous process of development, brought about by considering critical incidents in one's own life experience from a personal perspective
