Role Title	Football Referee (12 posts)
Description	As part of 'Active Universities', a project supported and funded by Sport England, Sheffield Hallam University Active require Football referees to help deliver our 5-a-side / 6-a-side and 11-a-side 2012/13 intramural Football competitions. The aim of the role is to referee matches between teams in a fair and impartial manner to increase the overall enjoyment and professionalism of our intramural Football competitions, as well as ensuring the health and safety of all participants is maintained at all times.
	As part of the Entry Level Football Referee course (provided by Sheffield Hallam University Active), you are required to referee 7 fixtures from the intramural league at Graves Park on Wednesday afternoons (on a voluntary basis). Please note that all equipment and transport to the venue is provided.
	By doing so, you will be offered paid work in the form of refereeing our 5-a-side & 6-a-side intramural football leagues at Collegiate Campus and Goals Soccer Centre.
