Approvals

Are you currently delivering or approved to deliver WorkSkills?

Centres currently offering WorkSkills or with WorkSkills approval will automatically be given qualification approval for the BTEC in STEM Leadership Skills.

Have you offered BTEC qualifications before?

Centres that are approved to offer BTEC qualifications can gain instant qualification approval for STEM via www.edexcelonline.co.uk by selecting BTEC">BTEC Approvals Schools and FE > Multiple Level Qualifications > WorkSkills Entry, 1, 2 you will be given approval for the entire WorkSkills suite of qualifications including STEM.

The Lead IV has responsibility for ensuring that all student work meets the required standards and level as well as all of the assessment criteria necessary to successfully gain a BTEC in WorkSkills.
