



Mobile Classroom



Aims and objectives

HeppSY+ (NCOP) aims to support the most disadvantaged young people in England to progress into higher education. The programme will undertake outreach activity in geographical areas where the higher education participation of young people is both low and much lower than expected based on GCSE-level attainment.

The mobile classroom provides local schools, colleges and communities with a visually exciting, innovative and alternative way of engaging students with higher educational themes by taking the mobile classroom out to the students.

About the bus

The mobile classroom is a double decker bus, enabling two simultaneous sessions to take place with different themes and content. It can accommodate between 30-35 students, with activities for students from Year 9-13.

Students can participate in group work and carry out research such as searching for courses via the UCAS website.

Activities and themes

The activities and themes follow our core offer strands of higher education knowledge, career knowledge, attainment and confidence/resilience.

Core Offer Strand	Theme Examples include:
Higher Education Knowledge	What is higher education? Why higher education (the benefits)? Student finance & budgeting UCAS
Career Knowledge	Pathways Graduate prospects
Attainment	Study skills Revision techniques
Confidence and resilience	Transition to higher education University life and societies

The sessions include presentations, workshop, activities, games and quizzes, and will be tailored to specific year groups.

As part of the HeppSY+ core offer, each target school and college will be offered the mobile classroom for a minimum of 2 days each.
