WHIRLOW GRANGE RESIDENTIAL COURSE

THE COURSE:

The course runs from Friday evening to late Sunday afternoon and uses towers in the Sheffield area for the practical sessions on 5, 6 or 8 bells.

Each student will be tutored in a method of their choice and will then practice that method at each of four tower-based practical sessions. Total time allocated to practice will be 6 hours.

The minimum requirement for acceptance as a student is competence in ringing rounds.

There will be talks on topics related to bellringing and a ringing tour on Saturday evening.

There will be opportunities to practise handbell ringing.
